"Freedom" Americana Sign

Supplies

- "Freedom" Wood cutout
- 4x20 Rectangle wood cutout
- Hazel & Ruby DIY Decor Tape "Americana"



- DecoColor Acrylic Pens in Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Violet, Aubergine, White, & Black
- ModPodge
- Americana Decor Brown Antiquing Wax
- Glue
- 24-inch strand of satin rattail cord in one of the above colors

Directions

- Apply the decor tape to the rectangle cutout
- 2. Protect/Secure the tape-covered rectangle with at least two coats of ModPodge.
- 3. Divide the "Freedom" cutout into seven equal sections. Since it is 14 inches long, you can make each section 2 inches wide.
- 4. Paint each section one of the sequential colors of the rainbow.
- Go back to the rectangle when the ModPodge is dry and lightly apply the antiquing wax to varioius areas of the rectangle with a cloth or stipple brush. Wipe away excess to suit your taste.
- 6. Paint the side edges of the Freedom cutout in white.
- 7. Carefully use a black paint pen or Sharpie to add a dark outline to the Freedom cutout to help it pop a bit more.
- 8. Glue the word cutout onto the center of the rectangle. Let Dry.
- 9. Add satin rattail for hanging
